Austin Health HMO3 General positions offer a variety of experiences including rotations in general, rehabilitation and intensive care medicine. HMO3s in the General stream also have the opportunity to rotate rurally to Mildura Base Hospital or Katherine District Hospital, NT.

There is also the ability to complete your Diploma of Obstetrics, with a six-month clinical placement at the Mercy Hospital.

Candidates who have completed this year have successfully undertaken training in the following areas: Anaesthetics, GP training, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Paediatrics and many more. Acceptance into a training program is not a pre-requisite for successful application to this stream.
