Thank you for your interest in applying for a position as a Surgical HMO (PGY3) at Austin Health.

Austin Health HMO3 Surgical positions include a variety of general and specialty surgical rotations, as well as ICU and Night duty. HMO3's in the surgical stream also have the opportunity to rotate to North West Regional Hospital, Burnie, Tasmania and Mildura Base Hospital for a general surgical rotation.

Candidates who have completed this year have successfully undertaken training in the following areas: SET training (Specialty and General Surgery), radiology, nuclear medicine, etc. Acceptance into a training program is not a pre-requisite for successful application to this stream, however completion of a satisfactory HMO2 Surgical stream year is a pre-requisite.
